

1006.28 Duties of district school board, district school superintendent; and school principal regarding K-12 instructional materials.— 2.3 a It is the responsibility and duty of the District School Board to provide oversight of all instructional materials used in the classroom. Each Florida school district must have a Board approved supplemental materials policy that requires any material used in the classroom or used to develop classroom materials must faithfully and accurately adhere to all Florida statutes including FS 1003.34, FS Chapter 847 and FS 1006.28, FS 1006.283, all Florida Child Abuse Statutes (FS Chapter 827) and all related State Board of Education Rules. The supplemental materials policy must include penalties for violation of the policy by any district personnel. Failure to do so by September 1, 2022 will be considered a willful violation of FS 1008.32.
